Half of the Water Users's and Sanitation Committee members must be women








92 % of all the Phase II supported WUSCs have minimum 50 % of women (in case of Phase II scheme) or minimum 33 % of women (in case of Phase I scheme) as Committee members.





- \* 99 % of all the WUSCs have at least one woman in a key position in the Committee
- Women hold 40 % of all the key positions available
- Among the women in key positions, most women work as Treasurers (55 %) followed by Secretaries (23 %), Vice-chairpersons (16 %) and Chairpersons (6 %)
- ❖ 10 % of all Chairperson positions, 34 % of Vice-Chairperson positions, 34 % of Secretary positions and 80 % of Treasurer positions are held by women.

- ❖ 17 % of our working Village Maintenance Workers are women
- 4 % of our schemes have female Village Maintenance Worker only.
